**Notification of the planned activity that may cause a significant adverse transboundary
environmental impact**

In accordance with Article 3 of the *Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context*, signed in Espoo on 25 February 1991, hereinafter referred to as the *Espoo Convention*, I hereby notify that the PGE EJ 1 Sp. z o.o. with its registered seat in Warsaw plans to implement a project involving the **Construction and operation of the first Nuclear Power Plant in Poland with a capacity of up to 3,750 MWe in the area of municipalities: Choczewo or Gniewino and Krokowa in Pomorskie Voivodeship.**

Under the proceedings concerning the planned activity, an environmental permit will be issued in accordance with Article 71(2)(1) of the *Act of 3 October 2008 on the provision of information on the environment and its protection, public participation in environmental protection and environmental impact assessments* (Journal of Laws of 2013, item 1235, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the *EIA Act*. It is an administrative decision that is mandatory to obtain further decisions making it possible to implement the project.

The procedure on the issue of an environmental permit covers proceedings on the environmental impact assessment. We hereby send you the information in accordance with Article 3 of the *Espoo Convention*, i.e.:

1. the information sheet for the project in electronic and paper form (Appendix 1) together with the necessary translation,
2. information about the procedure for environmental impact assessment and the bodies participating in the proceedings (Annex 2).

Please, confirm the receipt of this notification immediately. We also ask you to send information whether you intend to take part in the proceedings on the environmental impact assessment and to report your comments, if any, about the attached information sheet and the scope of environmental documentation **no later than 20 January 2016**.
