Requested clarifications by the European Commission concerning the Swedish National Programme for the safe and responsible management of spent fuel and radioactive waste under Council Directive 2011/70/Euratom

Member States shall provide for a national programme for the safe and responsible management of spent fuel and radioactive waste covering all the items provided for in Article 12 of Council Directive 2011/70/Euratom. Following the notification of the Programme in August 2015, the European Commission has requested from Sweden clarifications concerning the Programme.

The Swedish Radiation Safety Authority hereby provides the clarifications requested, as received by the Authority on 26 August 2016 (file SSM2016-3840-1), to the Commission concerning the Swedish National Programme.

The contents of the document have been communicated to the Government Offices of Sweden, Ministry of the Environment and Energy. It was also agreed that this letter, the attached clarification document and its translation into English, are to be sent by the Authority to the Commission through the Permanent Representation of Sweden to the European Union.
