Peer Review of SKB's Post-Closure Safety Reporting for a KBS-3 Repository

Dear Dr. Riotte

I am writing to inform you that the Swedish Radiation Safety Authority (SSM) will contribute 190,000 euro to support the NEA project "Peer Review of SKB's Post-Closure Safety Reporting for a KBS-3 Repository" NEA/RWM/PEER(2011)2, which is part of the Output Result 11 (Waste Management Policy and Governance) of the NEA Programme of Work 2011-2012.

The grant will be administered in accordance with the Financial Rules of the OECD which provide for the charging of a grant administrative charge, currently set at 6.8% of the offered amount.

This grant will be paid in three parts after receipt of an invoice, according to the following schedule and amounts:

- a first invoice for 95,000 euro after 1 May 2011
- a second invoice for 50,000 euro after 1 November 2011


