Dear colleagues,

In response to your letter dated on 24 March 2021, sign: NV-07138, providing us with document on capsules integrity so called „*Capsule Integrity Addendum, Swedish Enhanced TR-19-15 Summary – Additional Information on Capsule Integrity Issues*”, developed on the request of Swedish Court for Land and Real Estate at the district court in Nacka, I present the following information.

Republic of Poland, as an Affected Party taking part in a Transboundary EIA for encapsulation and final disposal of spent nuclear fuel in Forsmark, **does not have any comments** on the submitted document regarding capsule integrity

The given document was consulted at the national level with specialized authorities within environmental protection and nuclear safety in Poland. As a result of these consultations with concerned authorities such as: Regional Director for Environmental Protection in Szczecin, Regional Director for Environmental Protection in Gdańsk, Regional Director for Environmental Protection in Szczecin in Olsztyn, National Atomic Agency, National Center for Nuclear Research, Ministry of climate and Environment, National Geological Institute, Radioactive Waste Management Plant, **no comments were received as to the scope and content of the submitted document.**

Having in mind the public consultation in Sweden for the objective document, Poland made this document also available for the Polish public for period of 30 days with possibility to make comments and views, in order to insure same rights for Polish citizens. If any comments from public are made within public consultation then we will forward them immediately to the Swedish Party in a separate letter.

At the end I would like to inform you, that Polish Party is still interested in receiving further information in this case, in particular information on issued permits for implementation of planned project
